KNOW BEFORE YOU GO! TRANSFER TIPS

- ✓ The transfer degrees allow students to meet all or most lower division general education requirements. Once admitted to a bachelor's degree program, students can generally expect 90 transferable quarter credits and junior class standing.
- ✓ Students transferring without a transfer degree should contact admissions at the transfer institution to determine course equivalencies and transferability of Highline credits. Generally, courses are evaluated course-by-course.
- ✓ Connect with four-year colleges/universities. Ask about timelines, transfer admissions requirements and majors. Attend transfer information sessions if offered.
- ✓ Create a transfer degree plan with the help of a Highline College advisor and college/university major advisors. Know the major degree prerequisites and GPA requirements.
- ✓ Visit Highline's Transfer Center for resources, workshops and events.
